QUESTION

I am creating a small room below a staircase. It will have a number of fixtures and furnishings in it, and I would like to be able to see these in floor plan view, through the stairs. How can I make the stairs transparent so that I can see the items that will be located below them?





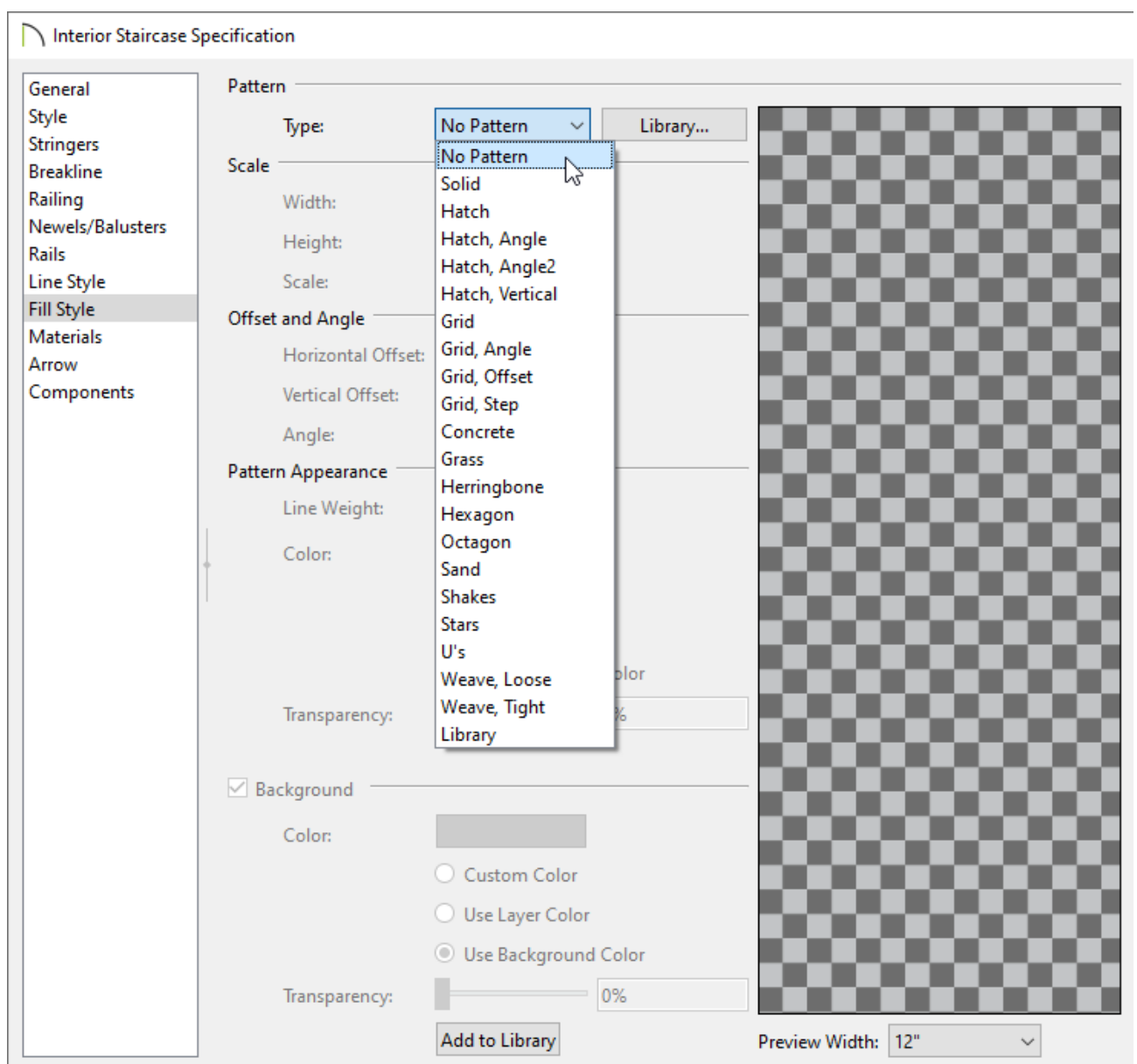
ANSWER

You can show the placement of items below stairs by making the stairs transparent in

a floor plan view.

To make a staircase transparent in floor plan view

1. Click the **Select Objects**  tool, then click on the stairs to select them and click the **Open Object**  edit button.
2. On the **FILL STYLE** panel of the **Staircase Specification** dialog, change the **Pattern Type** to **No Pattern**.




3. Click **OK** to close the dialog and apply the change.
