Drawing Stairs Down From a Deck or Porch

QUESTION

I need to create stairs that go from my deck and porch down to the ground. How do I do this?



ANSWER

The Straight Stairs tool can be used to easily place stairs between levels on the same floor or between a floor platform and the terrain with a single click.


Using the Straight Stairs tool

- 1. Open the Chief Architect plan in which you need stairs drawn from a deck, porch or other floor platform down to the terrain.
- 2. Select **Build> Stairs> Straight Stairs** from the menu.

Note: In Chief Architect X8 and prior, select **Build> Stairs> Click Stairs (**



3. Left-click once just outside the deck railing on the same level as the terrain.



We generally recommend creating your terrain on Floor 1 so in this context we would move to floor 1 and click just outside the deck railing. If the deck is on Floor 2, you can enable the Reference Floor Display \Longrightarrow to see the deck railings position on the floor above.
