QUESTION

I am creating a small room below a staircase. It will have a number of fixtures and furnishings in it, and I would like to be able to see these in floor plan view, through the stairs. How can I make the stairs transparent so that I can see the items that will be

located below them?



ANSWER

You can show the placement of items below stairs by making the stairs transparent in a floor plan view.

To make a staircase transparent in floor plan view

- Click the Select Objects tool, then click on the stairs to select them and click the
 Open Object edit button.
- 2. On the FILL STYLE panel of the **Staircase Specification** dialog, change the Pattern **Type** to **No Pattern**.



3. Click **OK** to close the dialog and apply the change.
