# Adding Wallpaper to a Room

## **QUESTION**

I would like to add wallpaper or wainscoting to my room or just to a single wall. How do I do this in Chief Architect?



#### **ANSWER**


Chief Architect provides several methods for adding materials to portions of your walls or an entire room using the Wall Covering feature.

In this article we will be covering:

- Adding a wall covering to an entire room
- Adding a wall covering to a single wall
- Controlling the span of a wall covering
- Replacing a wall covering
- Removing a wall covering

#### Adding a wall covering to an entire room

- 1. Using the **Select Objects** tool, select a room in your plan and click the **Open Object** edit button.
- 2. On the Wall Covering panel of the **Room Specification** dialog that opens, click the **Add New** button.



3. The Select Material dialog will appear next. Select a material of your choice to use

as the wall covering, then click **OK**.

4.	Use the Top To Ceiling, Height, and Floor To Bottom values to adjust the height of
	the wall covering and the distance off the floor.

- 5. To add multiple wall coverings, click the **Add New** button again to add an additional wall covering.
- 6. Click **OK** to confirm the changes.

#### Adding a wall covering to a single wall


- Using the Select Objects \( \strace{1}{2} \) tool, select a wall in your plan and click the Open
   Object \( \bigcirc \) edit button.
- 2. On the Wall Covering panel of the **Wall Specification** dialog that opens, click the **Add New** button.
- 3. In the **Select Material** dialog that opens next, select the material to be used as the wall covering, then click **OK**.
- 4. As with the room, use the **Top To Ceiling**, **Height**, and **Floor To Bottom** values to adjust the height of the wall covering and the distance off the floor
- 5. Click the **OK** to confirm the changes.

Using the Add New, Replace, and Delete buttons, you can add multiple wall coverings to a wall or room, replace an existing covering, or delete a covering.


#### Controlling the span of a wall covering

You may encounter a situation where one wall spans multiple rooms. If you need the wall covering to span only one room, you may need to break the wall.

- 1. Select the wall you want to add a break to, then click the **Add Break**  $\rightarrow$  edit button.
- 2. Click on the wall at the point that you want to break it at.



3. You can now select one of the wall segments to apply a wall covering to.



### Replacing a wall covering

Select the wall or room where the wall covering is applied and click the **Open** Object edit button.

2.	On the $W_{ALL}$ Covering panel, select the wall covering you want to replace using the $W_{ALL}$ Covering drop-down menu.	
3.	Click the <b>Replace</b> button, then select a new material from the library.	
4.	Repeat as necessary, then click <b>OK</b> .	
Removing a wall covering		
1.	Select the wall or room where the wall covering is applied and click the <b>Open Object</b> edit button.	
2.	On the Wall Covering panel, select the wall covering you want to remove using the $\boldsymbol{Wall}$ Covering drop-down menu.	
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3. Click the **Delete** button to remove the wall covering.

4. Repeat as necessary, then click **OK**.
